*gekruld, krullerig*

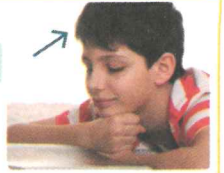
My brother has curly hair.

**device***apparaat*

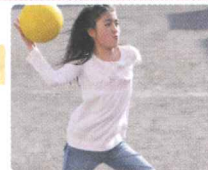
Can you imagine your life without these devices?
